

The Health (Amendment) (No 2) Act 2010 effective 1st October 2010

This Act provides for the payment of a charge of 50 cent by persons with full eligibility (GMS patients) per item dispensed by Community Pharmacy Contractors.

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GMS General Medical Services Scheme - This scheme provides for people who are unable without undue hardship to arrange general practitioner medical and surgical services to receive a medical card for free general medical services. Medicinal items are prescribed from a specified Reimbursement List.

DPS Drug Payment Scheme - This is a co-payment scheme for people who do not have a Medical Card - an individual or family has now to pay no more than €132 in a calendar month for approved drugs, medicines and appliances.

Long Term Illness Scheme - Drugs and Medicines are provided free of charge to patients who suffer from any of the 16 listed illnesses - Mental Handicap (under 16 years of age), Hydrocephalus, Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophy, Haemophilia, Diabetes Mellitus, Diabetes Insipidus, Epilepsy, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinsonism, Cystic Fibrosis, Phenylketonuria, Acute Leukaemia, Mental Illness, Spina Bifida and Thalidomide.
