#### **CHANGES IN PRICING AND REIMBURSEMENT**

An amendment to the General Social Insurance Law with changes to some pricing and reimbursement provisions for the out-patient sector was approved in Parliament on 31 March 2017:

- New regiment for determination of maximum reimbursement prices: The Pricing Commission determines prices 6, 24, and 48 months after the application for reimbursement of a product has been submitted. There is a further possibility of reassessment after 66 months.
- Products outside Code of Reimbursement: So called No-Box products that are not listed in the Code of Reimbursement (EKO) but are reimbursable due to their added therapeutic value are reimbursed at EU average price if a product surpasses a threshold of € 750.000 of annual revenue with the Social Insurance. The Social Insurance notifies the Pricing Commission at the Ministry if this applies for a product.
- Generics and Biosimilars price linkage: A differentiation has been introduced, where Biosimilars will enjoy easier access to the Code of Reimbursement.
- Products already listed in the green box of the Code of Reimbursement are only allowed to be priced up to 30% above the cheapest product within their group of identical active ingredient. This will be evaluated in 2017 and 2019.
