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Pricing

Price policies for pharmaceuticals

Statutory pricing - The State regulates the prices of the PO medicines and registers the prices of the OTC medicines. Prices of OTC drugs follow a simplified regulatory process.

Wholesale Mark-ups

Regressive scheme of the mark-ups, valid only for POM.

Pharmacy Mark-ups

Regressive mark-ups for POM

VAT

Standard VAT in Bulgaria is 20%. No exclusion or lower VAT for pharmaceuticals.

Reforms

The current pricing system exists since 2000, but has undergone trough some amendments. The procedure for statutory pricing of OTC products was simplified in 2003.

Reimbursement

Positive / negative list

Positive Drug List since 2003. In 2006, it included 574 INN – 2473 TN and consists of two parts – A and B.

Reimbursement lists of NHIF and MoH, based on the Positive list.

Reference Price System

Yes, 2002

Co-payment

Percentage co-payment according to 4 reimbursement groups of medicines

Mechanisms for vulnerable groups

No mechanisms in place to protect vulnerable groups.
