S P E C I A L	<p>E-HEALTH FOR MEDICINES</p> <p>Measure: Information Technology System for the implementation and support of the National Health Insurance System Provided by: Health Insurance Organisation Aim: A total solution regarding the IT System and other support services for the National Health Insurance System that will be implemented in Cyprus Target group: All beneficiaries and all providers (private and public) Further information: The agreement for the building of the IT System was signed in March 2017, after a long tender procedure (Competitive Dialogue), for a total cost of about 40 million euro, 20% of which amount will be used for the building of the system and 80% for the operation (claims adjudication) for a period of 5 years.</p> <p>Measure: Deployment of generic Cross Border eHealth in Cyprus: Provision of services for implementing the connector for the mapping of the epSOS Patient Summary and ePrescription and eDispensing data sets with the existing public hospital systems Provided by: Ministry of Health Aim: To comply with the Cross Border Healthcare Directive 2011/24/EU Target group: European citizens within the scope of the Cross Border Healthcare Directive Further information: To be in place Q1, 2019</p>
