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Pricing

- Price policies for pharmaceuticals statutory pricing for reimbursable pharmaceuticals at ex-factory price level external price referencing for reimbursable pharmaceuticals (13 EU Countries) generic regulation (-30%, -10%, -10%)
- Wholesale Mark-ups for reimbursed pharmaceuticals, regressive scheme
- Pharmacy Mark-ups for reimbursed pharmaceuticals, regressive scheme
- VAT5 % standard rate on pharmaceuticals
- Reforms
 1st May 2004 implementation of the Transparency directive

Reimbursement

- Positive list
 - 4.698 pharmaceuticals included on positive list (including different packages, dosages) (1st June 2007.)
- Reference Price System
 since 1991 at ATC 7 level, but from
 2000 at ATC 5 level too
 Possibility for tendering the reference
 price publicly
- Co-payment

normative: 15%, 45%, 75% indication dependent: 10%, 30%, 50% or 300 HUF = 1,2 EUR

- Mechanisms for vulnerable groups
 exemption from co-payment for
 socially disadvantaged groups (max.
 6.000 HUF = 24 EUR or for specialist's
 indications [e.g.: gastroenterologist,
 cardiologist] 12.000 HUF = 48 EUR)
- Reforms
 1st May 2004 implementation of the
 Transparency directive
