# • Price policies for pharmaceuticals

Non-statutory pricing for pharmaceuticals supplied to health service (including those reimbursable) at ex-factory price level

Price may not exceed average of ex-factory prices in 9 specified EU Member States

## Wholesale mark-ups

All reimbursable pharmaceuticals; one linear model for all reimbursement categories

### Pharmacy mark-ups

General Medical Services (GMS) Scheme: no mark-up

Community Drug (i.e. Non GMS) Schemes: linear model

### VAT

Oral pharmaceuticals 0% Others 21%

### Reforms

2006: Government devolved to the Health Service Executive control over the supply terms, conditions and prices of medicines supplied to the health services

# Reimbursement

### Positive list

General Medical Services (GMS) and certain other Schemes: Core List

Number of pharmaceuticals included on Core List: ca. 3450 (May 2007)

# Reference price system

None

## Co-payment

Drugs Payment Scheme (DPS): Max. €85 per individual or family per month

## Mechanisms for vulnerable groups

General Medical Services (GMS) and some other Schemes: no payment

### Reforms

2005: the Health Service Executive (HSE) was established to take over the management of the Irish Health Services

The functions of the Health Boards together with those of other boards/agencies (including reimbursement) transferred to the HSE
