Pricing and reimbursement system of medical devices

- Competent authority: The National Health Service is responsible for elaboration of the Positive list of reimbursable medical devices (the decision on reimbursement of medical devices is application based).
- **Price regulation:** General principles of the reimbursement system of pharmaceuticals and medical devices are set out in Regulation of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Latvia No.899 of 31 October 2006.

For medical devices the same pricing principles are applied as for reimbursable pharmaceuticals:

- free pricing at the manufacturer's price level, regressive wholesale and pharmacy mark up schemes set by the Regulation;
- external and internal reference pricing.
- Reimbursement: According to the Regulation the following medical devices are reimbursed:
