

Changes in pricing

No changes.

Pricing is regulated for medicines from EML: ex-factory price + 10 % wholesale mark-up + 25 % retail mark-up.

Medicines with are subject of “Affordable Medicines” State Programme (23 INNs): ex-factory price + 10 % wholesale mark-up + 15 % retail mark-up.

Other medicines: ex-factory price + 10 % wholesale mark-up + 10 % retail mark-up.

Changes in reimbursement

Pilot project on reimbursement of insulins (8 INNs, 70 brand names) continues. Reference price registry is approved by MoH.

Since the 1st of April 2018: State Programme “Affordable Medicines”: New INNs were added ⇨ 23 INN (approx. 240 brand names, 48 of them are reimbursed 100 %) – medicines for cardiovascular diseases, bronchial asthma, diabetes mellitus of II type (except insulins).

Other changes

- **National Essential Medicines List** was updated (+ 54 INNs).

Special topic: Patient Involvement in Pricing and Reimbursement of Medicines
