State Medicines' Pricing and Reimbursement Agency

#### Major reforms from 2007 till now

- VAT rise

Standard rate from 18% to 21% reduced rate for pharmaceuticals from 5% to 10% (since 01/2009)

## Current and planned measures

- Changes of reimbursement rates from 90% to 75% and from 75% to 50% (will enter in force in 03/2009)

## Current pharmaceutical pricing and reimbursement system (as of 2/2009)

### Pricing

- Price policies

Non reimbursable pharmaceuticals – free pricing;

Reimbursable pharmaceuticals – statutory pricing after price negotiations at pharmacy purchasing price level

#### - Wholesale mark up

2 different regressive schemes for reimbursable and non-reimbursable pharmaceuticals

#### - Pharmacy mark up

2 different regressive schemes for reimbursable and non-reimbursable pharmaceuticals

#### - VAT

21% - standard rate

10% - reduced rate for pharmaceuticals

#### Reimbursement

- Positive list
  - YES; 1108 pharmaceuticals included in the positive list (Jan 2008)
- **Reimbursement rates** for pharmaceuticals on the positive list 100%, 90%, 75% and 50%
- **Reference price system** since July 2005
- Co-payments

Percentage co-payment of 10%, 25% or 50%
