Pricing

Price policies for pharmaceuticals Voluntary agreement with industry (PPRS) - Prices regulated by profit cap. Allows freedom of pricing at launch for new molecules, prices frozen thereafter, subject to profit levels.

Wholesale mark-ups

Notional 12.5% margin for branded medicines, but wholesalers allowed to set own margins.

Pharmacy mark-ups

Pharmacy margins are not regulated, but are monitored and counted towards pharmacy income.

VAT

Zero rated for NHS medicines dispensed by pharmacies. Drugs dispensed in hospitals subject to standard rate (17.5%).

Reforms

Reform of generics reimbursement price arrangements in 2005.

Reimbursement

Positive list

No - All medicines prescribed by doctors fully reimbursed except those on the 'black' or 'grey' list.

Reference Price System

No.

Co-payment

Flat charge of £6.85 per prescription item (except Wales where there is no charge). Also, annual 'season ticket' @ £98.

Mechanisms for vulnerable groups

Exemption from prescription charges for children, older people, low incomes, war veterans, and certain medical conditions.
