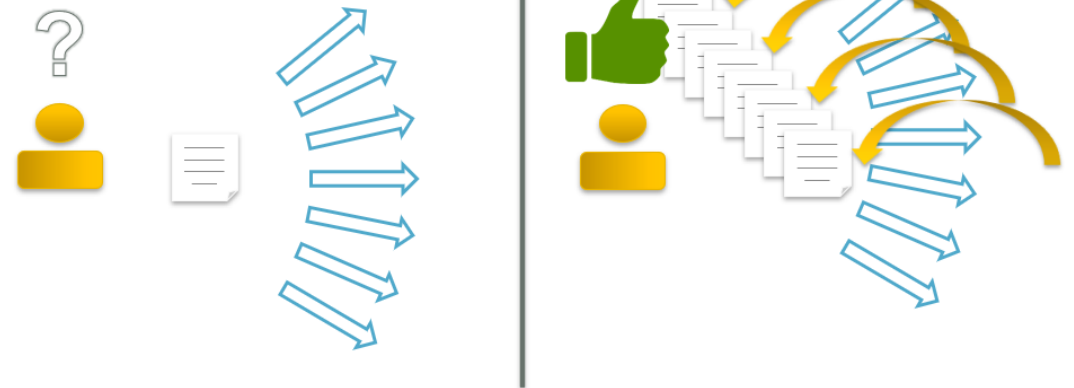

# PPRI Network queries

- **Purpose:** to have quick & ad-hoc access to information and data on specific questions in other countries
- **Topics, e.g.:**
  - to collect a price of products or active ingredients
  - to learn about the reimbursement status of products or active ingredients
  - to collect consumption data of products or active ingredients
  - related to other issues within pharmaceutical system

- ✓ Use the latest version of the PPRI mailing list
- ✓ Copy in [ppri@goeg.at](mailto:ppri@goeg.at) (also in replies!)
- ✓ Use the appropriate template
- ✓ Explain the purpose of the query

- ✓ Set deadlines (usually two weeks)
- ✓ Prepare and share a compilation

**'Guiding Principles' for PPRI network queries**

The purpose of PPRI network queries is to have quick access to information and data on specific questions related to medicines in other member countries. Queries in this field could be about prices, reimbursement status, consumption data of a product or active ingredient or other related issues.

Within the PPRI network we established 'guiding principles' for queries:  
PPRI network members are kindly asked to comply with the following principles when they launch a PPRI query or participate in it.

<b>Check the previous compilations</b>	Before launching a query the PPRI Secretariat recommends to check the existing compilations in the Intranet in order to avoid duplicates.
<b>Use the latest version of the mailing list</b>	The PPRI participants are encouraged to use the latest updated mailing list which is available at the PPRI Members Only site or from the PPRI Secretariat ( <a href="mailto:ppri@goeg.at">ppri@goeg.at</a> ). This list contains the current e-mail addresses of the members of the PPRI network and the e-mail address of the PPRI Secretariat: <a href="mailto:ppri@goeg.at">ppri@goeg.at</a>
<b>Copy to <a href="mailto:ppri@goeg.at">ppri@goeg.at</a></b>	Please also copy in the PPRI Secretariat ( <a href="mailto:ppri@goeg.at">ppri@goeg.at</a> ) when launching a PPRI Network Query!
<b>Use templates</b>	... for pricing and consumption queries easy-to-use templates in *.xls format called 'PPRI Price Query Template MMYY' or 'PPRI Consumption Query Template MMYY' which are available at the PPRI Members Only site or from the PPRI Secretariat. ... for reimbursement queries a *.doc template called 'PPRI Reimbursement Query Template MMYY' was developed (also available at the PPRI Intranet or from the PPRI Secretariat).
<b>Explain purpose</b>	The participant launching a PPRI Network Query is asked to briefly explain the reason and purpose of the query and to indicate a contact person for questions.
<b>Provide an example</b>	Please also pre-fill your query with your own country data to deliver an example for answering.

**Answering**

The answers to the PPRI Network Query should only be sent directly to the participant asking for it, not to the full group so not to overload the mailboxes. The PPRI Secretariat ([ppri@goeg.at](mailto:ppri@goeg.at)) should always be copied in.

When answering a PPRI Network Query, please make sure to always add your country code at the end of your file name.

**Set deadlines**

Please set a date for answering (usually two weeks). Return your answer within two weeks if no specific deadline is mentioned.

**Prepare a compilation and share**

The PPRI participant who launched a query should compile a consolidated version of the results and send it to the PPRI network members incl. the PPRI Secretariat (who takes care about uploading it on the PPRI Member site).

The consolidated version should include a Disclaimer stating the following text:

'The data contained in this document have been provided by the members of the PPRI network and represent the current situation. The data have no legally binding value and are meant exclusively for the information of PPRI network members who are committed to sharing information on pharmaceutical pricing and reimbursement.' The disclaimer has been integrated in the query templates.

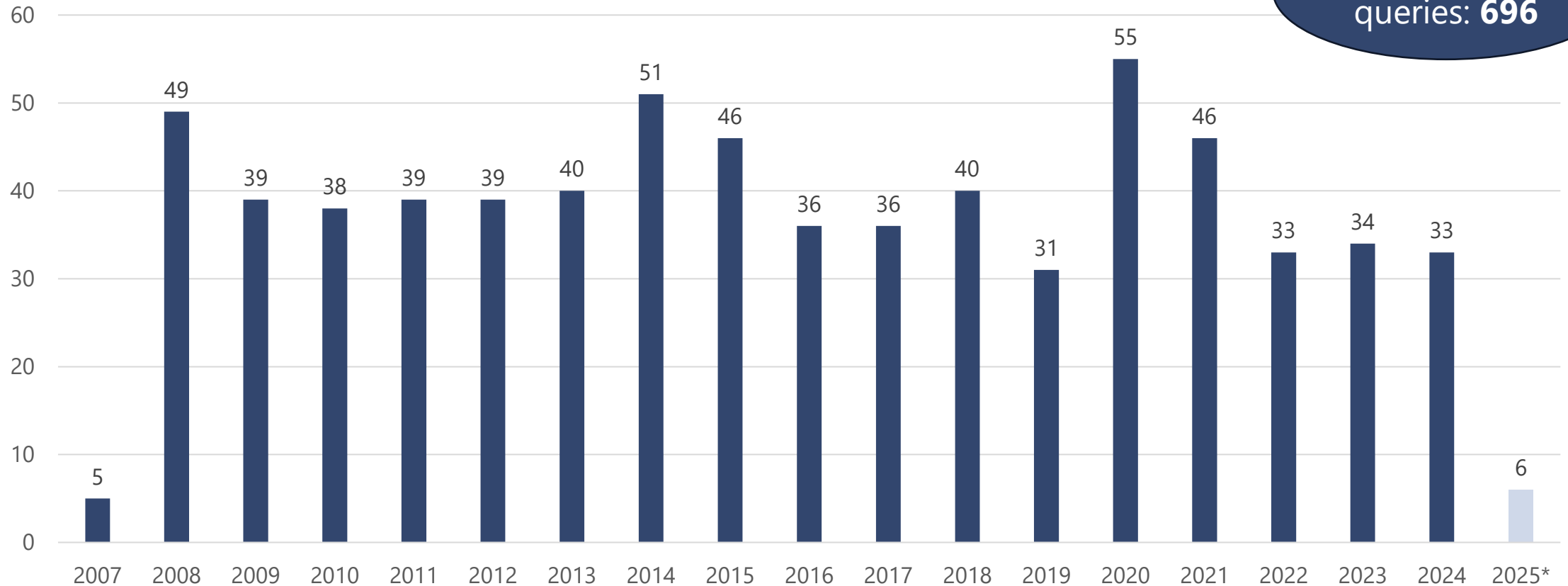

## Number of network queries from 2007 – 2025\*

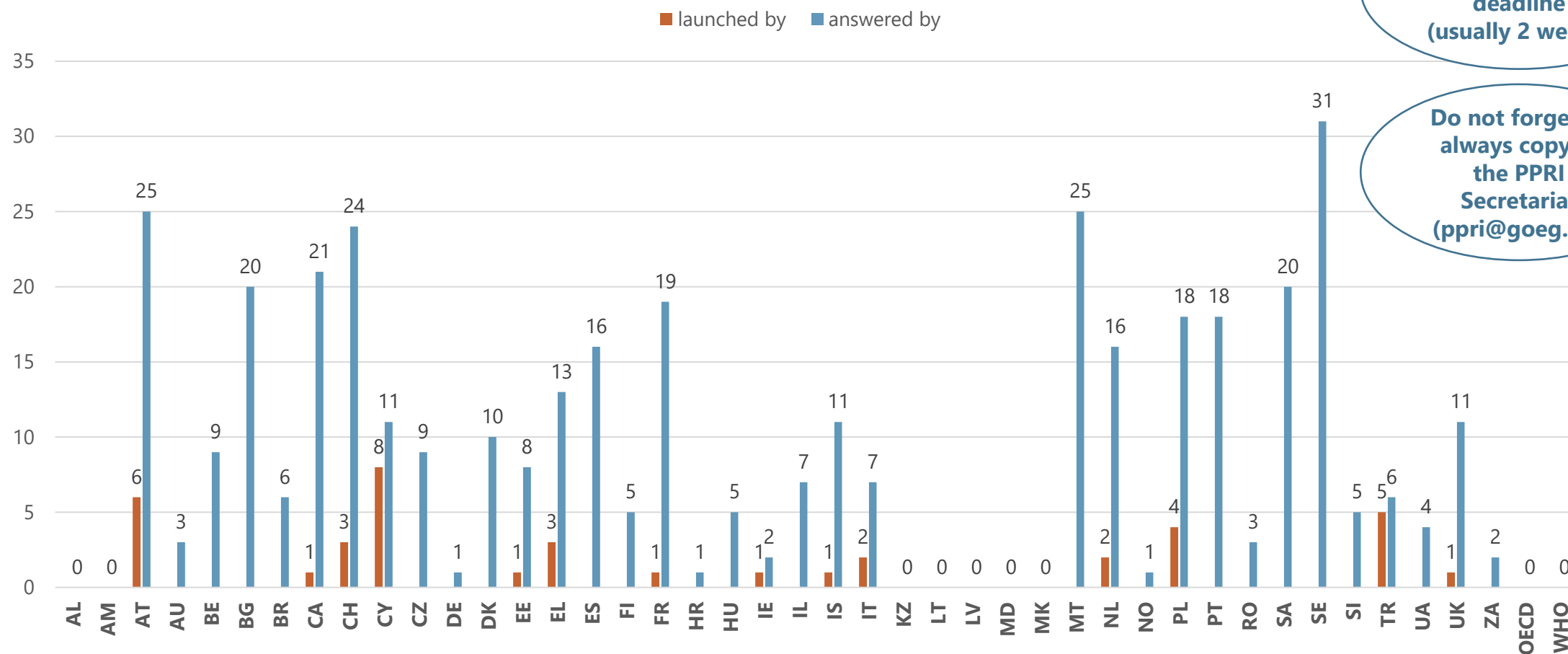

## Number of responses per country (Jan 2024 – Feb 2025)

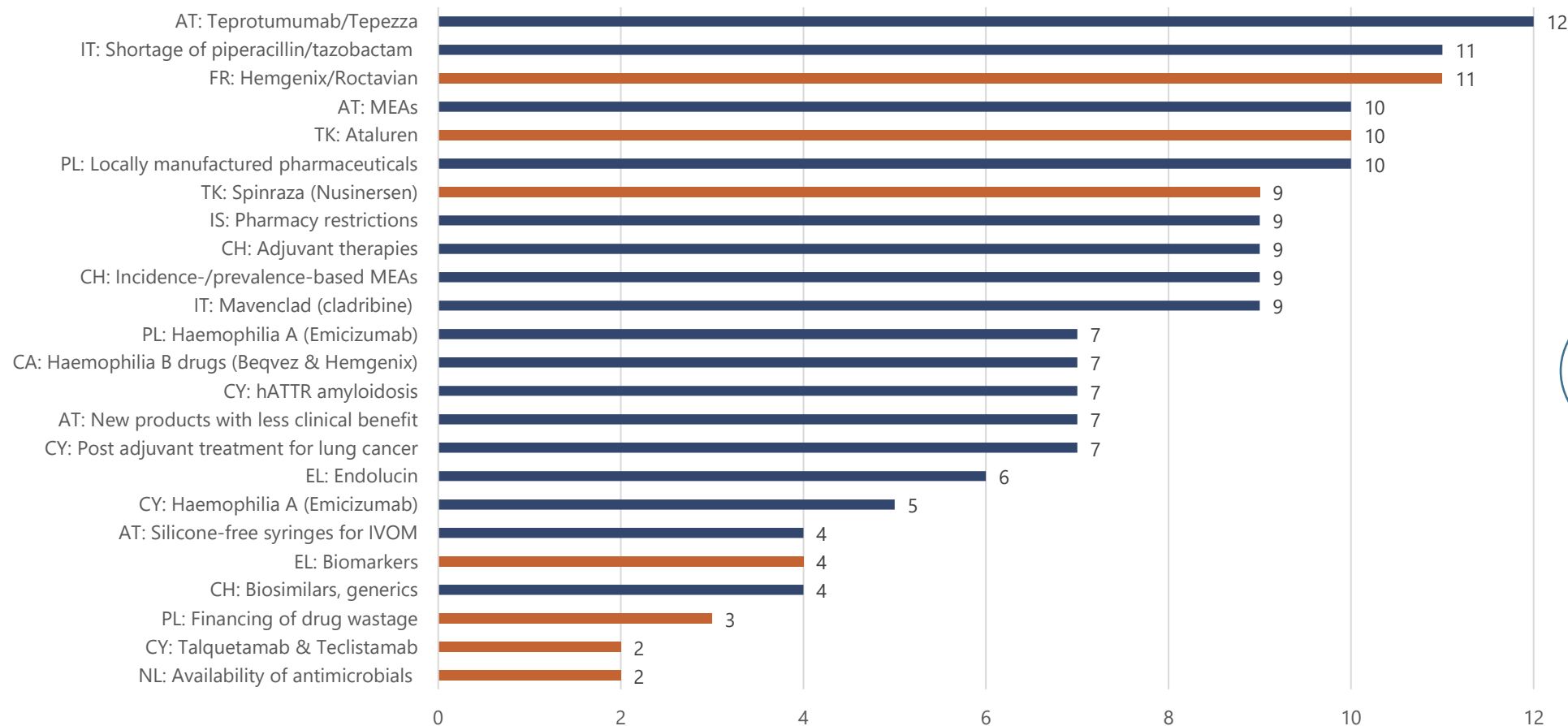

## Number of responding countries per query (Jan 2024 – Feb 2025)



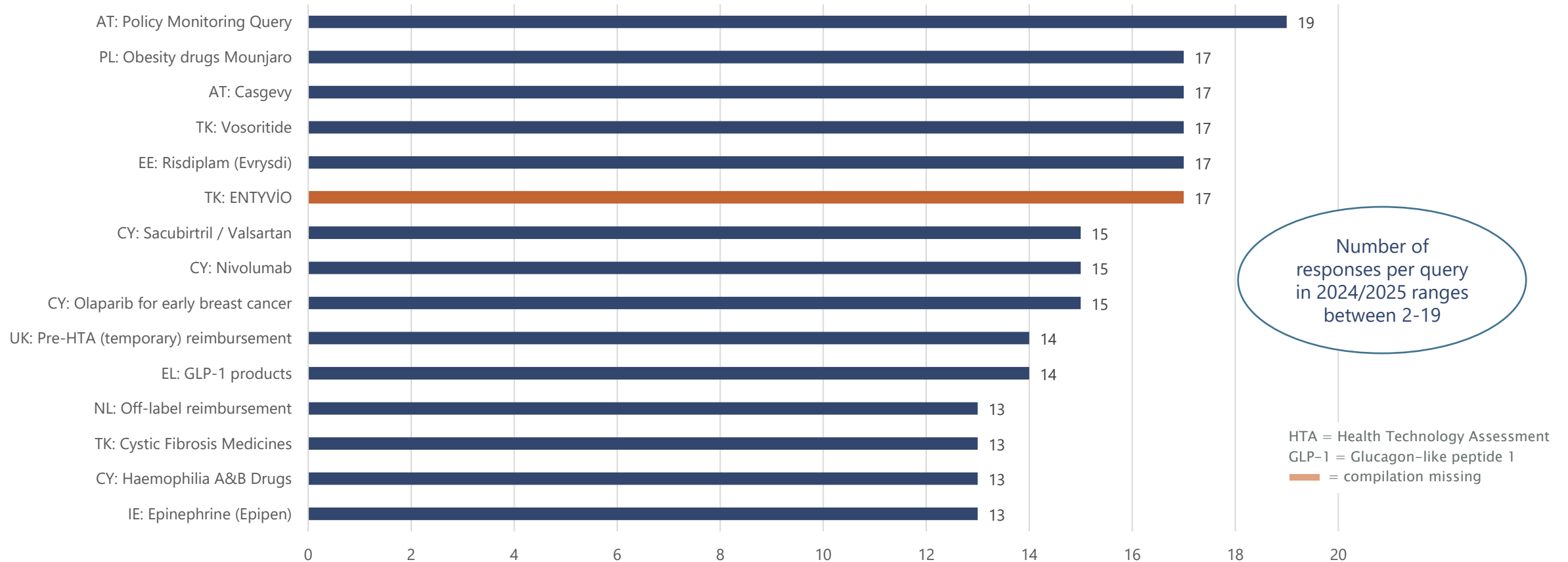
