## Pharmaceutical Pricing & Reimbursement Information Network of Authorities in Africa (PPRI Africa)

Many African countries currently have pharmaceutical reimbursement and pricing policies in place and/or are (further) working on establishing such policies. However, there is variation in implementation. Also, there are some networks or efforts of government authorities to join forces on both global and regional level regarding this topic. Out of these efforts, the Pharmaceutical Pricing and Reimbursement Information (PPRI) network is the most important one. The PPRI network coordinated by the Austrian National Public Health Institute (Gesundheit Österreich GmbH) is mainly targeted towards European institutions. Even if the network has expanded beyond Europe (in regional networks), there is not yet a dedicated regional network for the African continent.

Project BEL21003-10056 aims at the establishment of such a network for African countries. With support from the Team Europe Initiative on Manufacturing and Access to vaccines, medicines and health technologies in Africa (TEI MAV+), the project allows to test the establishment of a small network for one year, evaluate and eventually recommend to sustainably continue to maintain such an African network as PPRI Africa.



This project aims at the establishment of a network for African countries intended to allow public authorities working on pricing and reimbursement of pharmaceuticals to learn about policies, compare implemented mechanisms and improve their targeted imple-

mentation in the respective country and regional contexts to better manage the impact of pharmaceutical prices on the public and private budgets.

Gesundheit Österreich Forschungs und Planungs GmbH (GÖ FP) was commissioned by Enabel to provide the required technical support for the setup of PPRI Africa as its secretariat. The project will be carried out from 01/2025 to 12/2025. Main activities include the establishment of the network, an inaugural network meeting in March 2025, the establishment of a knowledge platform and performance of online trainings.
