

## **OTHER CHANGES**

Unification of software used in health care (prescribing software, hospital

sortware):
A centrally developed software, integrated to the e-health system is under development and will have to be used by the health care providers in the future.

## SPECIAL TOPIC:

Developing and implementing pharmaceutical policies in view of the current challenges (soaring inflation, medicine price increases, increasing no. of medicine shortages)

- - National register to report shortages: in place (mandatory)
     Export ban / notification for medicines targeted by shortage: no current ban is in place

  - Regulatory measures: no changes
     Financial measures: no changes
     Stakeholder involvement: no change

  - a) medicines included in the out-patient reimbursement list: Marketing authorisation holders can submit applications for price increase. The appraisal is based on HTA, no special criteria are applied. Increasing number of requests have been received in recent times. b) medicines outside out-patient reimbursement list: free pricing
  - c) medicines inpatient: listed on the general reimbursement list, same price increase procedure than for out-patient medicines
